

THE LITTLE RED HEN

The little Red Hen really wanted some help from the other animals to plant the seed, harvest the crop, grind the wheat and turn the flour into bread. But no one wanted to help her with all these boring tasks, so she didn't share the bread when it was finally ready to eat! Perhaps her problem was that bread is basically a boring food. Can your team imagine a more appealing food and develop an interesting process to create it so that the other animals will want to help?

Challenge: Invent an attractive new food and an intriguing production process to encourage other creatures to participate in a group effort to make food for everyone.

Time: Part One: You will have 4 minutes to develop a tasty new food, an interesting way to produce that food and a presentation to convince the other animals to share the work and the results with the little Red Hen.

Part Two: You will have 1 minute to present your new food and how it is made to the appraisers. (Perhaps they will also want to join in!)

Materials: a sheet of paper and a pencil (for planning your solution only)

Scoring: up to 30 points for the innovation of the new food
up to 30 points for the appeal of the food production process
up to 15 points for the effectiveness of the presentation
up to 25 points for positive team work
