

# SNOW SCULPTURE

There really hasn't been enough snow here (yet!) to build anything interesting with the cold, white stuff. But Creative Problem Solvers can use all kinds of things to make their own fun with "snow"!

**Challenge:** Build a really creative "snow" figure from the provided materials while you write a short play about your activities this winter. Make sure your "snow" sculpture has a central role in your story!

**Time:** Part One: You will have 4 minutes to develop a story and construct a "snow" figure.

Part Two: You will have 2 minutes to show off your "snow" character and perform your skit for the appraisers.

**Materials:** one dozen sugar cubes  
one dozen mini marshmallows  
one dozen regular marshmallows  
one dozen white candies (peppermint Lifesavers, for example)  
some white cake frosting  
(The packaging materials may not be included in the solution.)

**Scoring:** up to 20 points for the creativity of your story  
up to 20 points for the creativity of your "snow" figure  
up to 20 points for the integration of your character into the story  
up to 20 points for the creative use of materials  
up to 20 points for positive team work
