

PASSPORTS

Passports are identification papers given by governments to their citizens. You need to show one of your own when you cross a border into another country. The mice are anxious to get started on their trip around the world, but they just remembered that they don't have passports! The United States government won't issue them American passports because they aren't human. And the Destination ImagiNation passports are for teams solving the challenges, not travelling. Maybe the international community of creative problem solvers should have their own passports!

Challenge: Design a creative new passport to identify problem solvers from all around the world. Make individual ones for each of your team members, including a picture. The mice will need to show theirs at the border posts of many countries as they travel around the world, so make one for them, too!

Time: Part One: You will have 5 minutes to design a new passport for creative problem solvers and make one for each of your team members and also one for the mice.

Part Two: You will have 1 minute to present your creations to the appraisers.

Materials: lots of sheets of plain paper
colored markers

Scoring: up to 30 points for the innovation of the new passport design
up to 30 points for the uniqueness of the individual passports
up to 15 points for the creativity of the mouse passport
up to 25 points for positive team work
