Challenge: What would Sasquatch think about humans if he could observe your team in action?

Time: Part One: You will have 4 minutes to create a performance about what Sasquatch would see if he was watching your DI team. What might surprise him about human behavior?

Part Two: You will have 2 minutes to present your solution to the appraisers.

Materials: a sheet of paper and a pencil (for planning your solution only)

Scoring: up to 20 points for the creativity of the Sasquatch character
up to 40 points for the description of the qualities of your DI team members that surprised Sasquatch
up to 15 points for the effectiveness of the presentation
up to 25 points for positive team work
